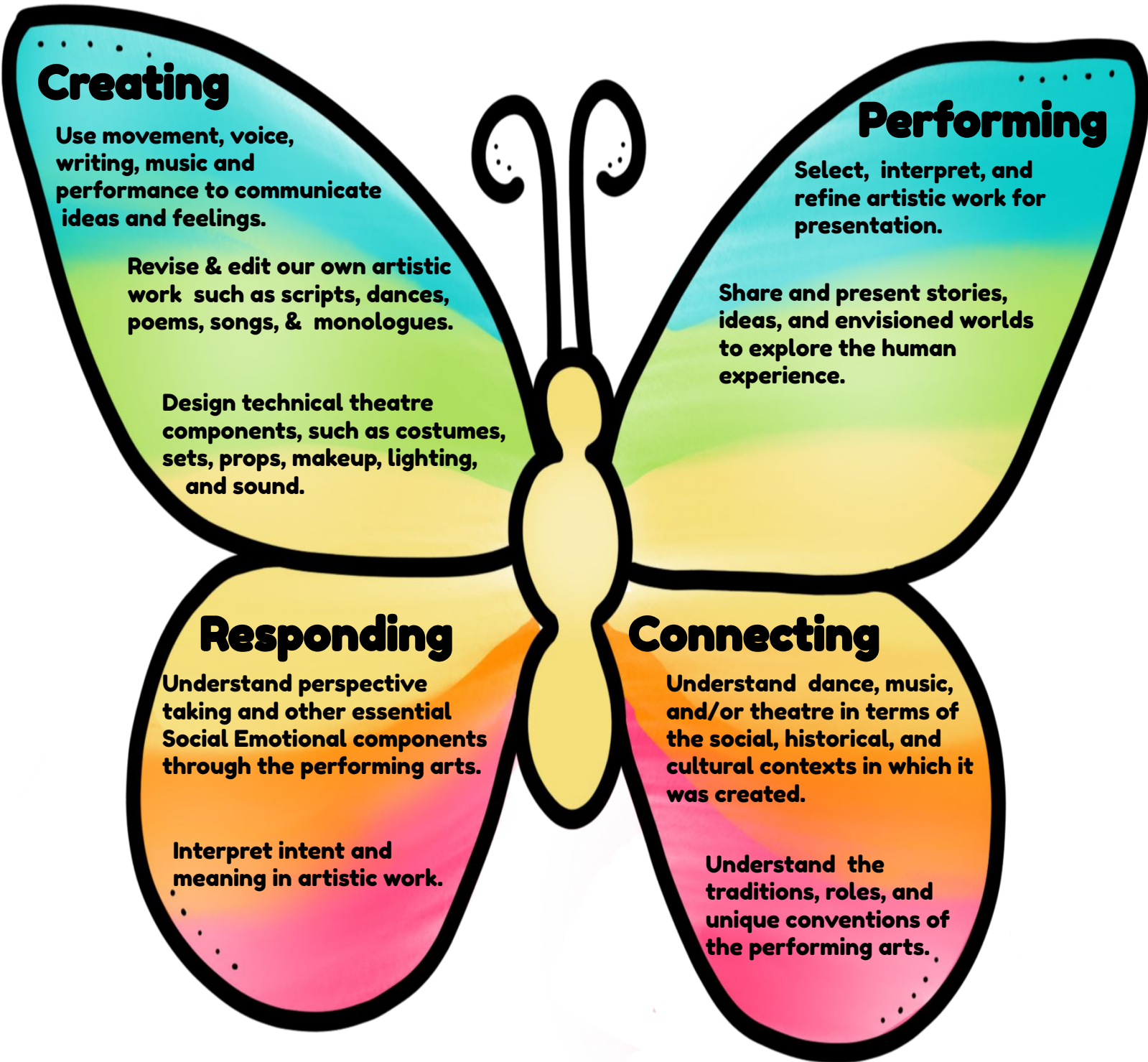


Welcome!

Performing Arts OQS

At center of the butterfly is our performing artist, who will learn various processes of the performing arts focusing on and following the National Core Arts Standards of creating, performing, responding, & connecting.



**Creating**

Use movement, voice, writing, music and performance to communicate ideas and feelings.

Revise & edit our own artistic work such as scripts, dances, poems, songs, & monologues.

Design technical theatre components, such as costumes, sets, props, makeup, lighting, and sound.

**Performing**

Select, interpret, and refine artistic work for presentation.

Share and present stories, ideas, and envisioned worlds to explore the human experience.

**Responding**

Understand perspective taking and other essential Social Emotional components through the performing arts.

Interpret intent and meaning in artistic work.

**Connecting**

Understand dance, music, and/or theatre in terms of the social, historical, and cultural contexts in which it was created.

Understand the traditions, roles, and unique conventions of the performing arts.
